It is proposed to fill-up the following posts in the Directorate General of Employment, Ministry of Labour & Employment on deputation basis and deputation (ISTC)/absorption basis:

(i) One post of Sub-Regional Employment Officer/Officer on Special Duty (Group 'B'-Gazetted) in Level 7 (revised) on Deputation basis in the Directorate General of Employment (HQ), New Delhi from amongst the officers under the Central or State Government.

(a) i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre/department; or
ii) with three years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the pay Level 6 (Revised) or equivalent in the parent Cadre/Department; and

(b) Possessing the educational qualification and experience mentioned below:- Essential

(i) Master's Degree in Social Welfare or Social Work or Economics or Statistics or Psychology or Commerce or Education of a recognized University or equivalent.

(ii) Three years' experience of Socio-Economic Investigation or Research preferably in relation to demography, employment and unemployment or manpower problems.

(iii) Knowledge of Employment Service work.

Desirable: Experience of employment exchange operations.

(ii) One post of Data Processing Assistant Grade B (Group 'B' Gazetted) in Level 7 (revised) on Deputation basis in the Directorate General of Employment (HQ), New Delhi from amongst the officers under the Central Government :

(c) (i) Master's degree in any discipline of the recognised University or equivalent or Bachelor's degree in Engineering of a recognised University or equivalent; and

(ii) three years' experience in electronic data processing work including experience of actual programming; or

(d) (i) 'A' Level Diploma under Department of Electronics Accredited Computer Courses or Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Application offered under University programme or post Polytechnic Diploma in Computer Application awarded by State Council of Technical Education or equivalent; and

(ii) three years' experience of electronic data processing work including experience of actual programming.

(iii) Three posts of Sub-Regional Employment Officer (Group 'B'-Gazetted) in Level 7 on Deputation including Short Term Contracts (ISTC)/Absorption basis in the National Career Service Centre for SC/STs from amongst the officers of the Central Government, State Governments, Union Territories, Autonomous Bodies or Statutory Organisations, Public Sector Undertakings, Government Universities or Recognised Research Institutions:

(a) i) Holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or
ii) With five years' regular service in Level 6 of the pay matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre or Department; and

(B) Possessing the educational qualification and experience mentioned below:- Essential:

(i) Master's Degree in Social Welfare or Social Work or Sociology or Labour Welfare or Economics or Statistics or Psychology or Commerce or Education of a recognized University;

(ii) Three years' experience in matters pertaining to:

(a) Collection, analysis and interpretation of data or socio-economic investigation or research relating to demographic, employment and manpower problems; or

(b) Employment Service Operations including Employment Market Information; or

(c) Vocational Guidance and Employment Counselling; or

(d) Personnel Organization and Management.

Desirable: Knowledge of Computer Operation.

Note : The Central Government or State Government or Union Territories officers shall only be considered for absorption.

(b) Possessing the following educational qualifications and experience:

Essential:

(i) Master's Degree in Social Welfare or Social Work or Sociology or Labour Welfare or Economics or Statistics or Psychology or Commerce or Education of a recognized University or Institute;

(ii) Two years' experience in matters pertaining to:

(a) Collection, analysis and interpretation of data or socio-economic Investigation or research relating to demographic, employment and manpower problems; or

(b) Employment Service Operations including Employment Market Information; or

(c) Vocational Guidance and Employment Counselling; or

(d) Personnel Organization and Management.

Desirable: Knowledge of Computer Operation

2. The period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organization/Dept. of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The Departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation.

3. The posts of SREO/OSD and DPA Grade B are DGE (HQ), New Delhi based posts. The vacancies for the post of SREO are at Aizawl (Mizoram), Jabalpur (M.P.) and Nagpur (Maharashtra) Centres. The vacancies for the post of AEO are at Bengaluru and Kolkata Centres. The number of vacancies advertised are tentative and subject to change without prior notice. The posts carry all India liability and persons selected can be posted anywhere in India under the Directorate General of Employment.
